
North Sumatra Cultural Diversity: Introducing Malay and Batak Oral Tradition and Local Wisdom

These cultural elements—such as oral literature, traditional dances, and craftsmanship—represent historical treasures that need to be preserved. The course emphasizes the importance of sustaining and promoting these traditions to future generations, especially within the local communities of North Sumatra.

This program explores the richness of Malay and Batak cultural heritage, including rituals, arts, and the iconic handwoven textile known as ulos. Participants will gain insights into the meaning and relevance of local wisdom and traditional practices. The course offers not only academic learning but also experiential activities such as cultural excursions to areas surrounding Lake Toba and regions renowned for ulos weaving.
